## 2023 PKLA Annual Meeting Minutes

PKLA Director Mike Carter welcomed membership to the Annual Meeting. Approximately 175 lake residents attended. Mike introduced special guest and elected officials.

Guest Speakers included State Representative Dr. Glenn Rogers, District 60, which includes Stephens, Palo Pinto and Parker Counties. Representative Rogers gave a report on 88th Legislative Session and the Special Session that followed.

Brazos River Authority CEO David Collingsworth spoke to the crowd about the changes with the PK Lake Rangers. Collingsworth introduced Palo Pinto County Sheriff Brett McGuire whose department will taking over policing the waters at PK. An Interlocal Agreement with BRA and the County was negotiated and signed by both the County and BRA boards.

He reviewed to the attendees the TCEQ permit that has been applied for by the City of Abilene to release effluents from a water treatment plant in Breckenridge back into PK Lake in the Cedar Creek area. He explained that data is required to determine how the effluents might affect water quality. David stayed and answered questions afterwards.

Kirk Kennedy, PKLA Hydrologist, and Mert Fewell, PKLA Director, responded to the BRA position with a power point presentation that included the Cedar Creek flow data.

United Coop employee Kanyon Payne presented a power point presentation on Coop efforts to provide highspeed Internet to the PK Lake community.

A Question & Answer session followed.
